


How to create a board in Confluence

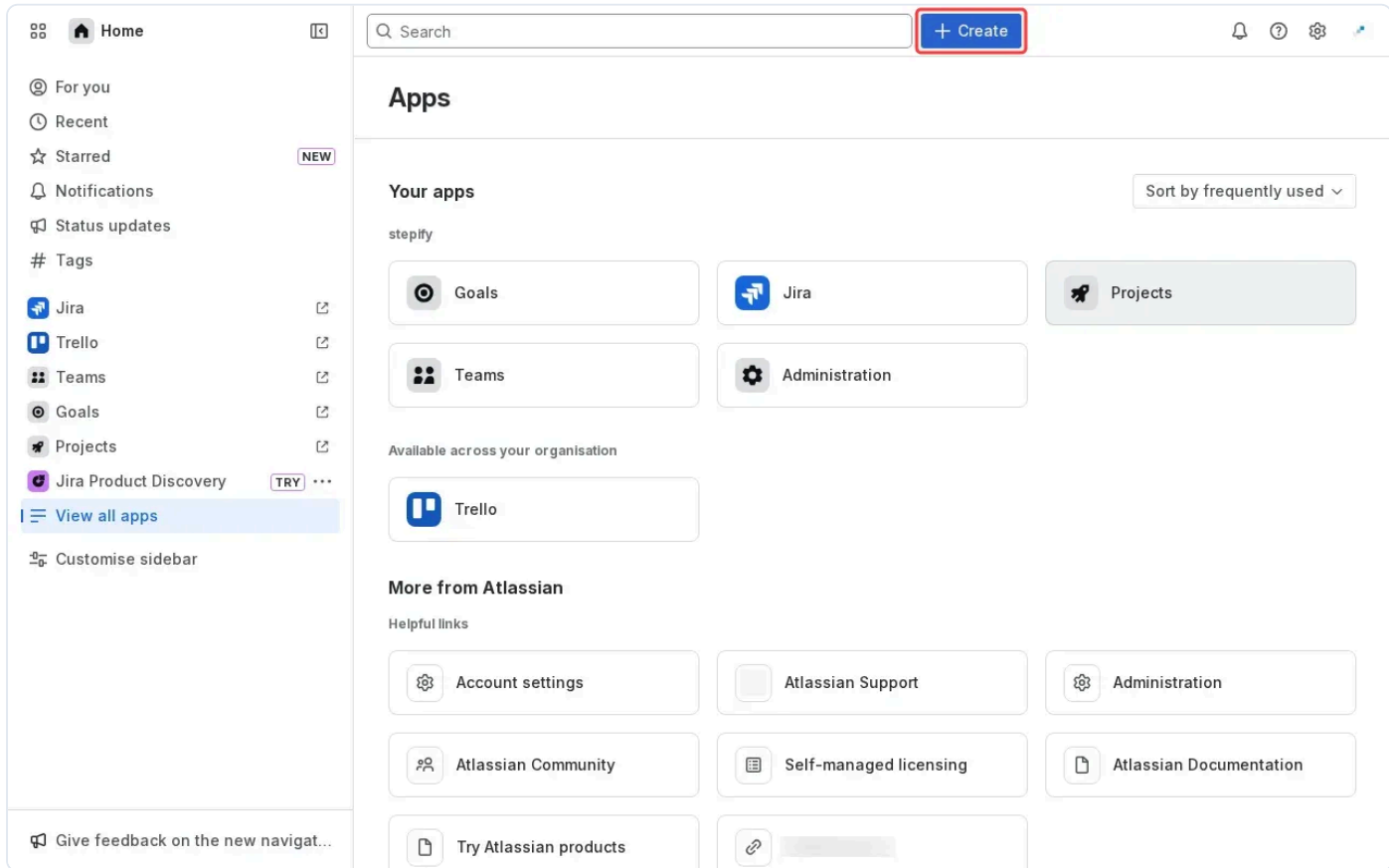

1 Click 'View all apps' to find Confluence.

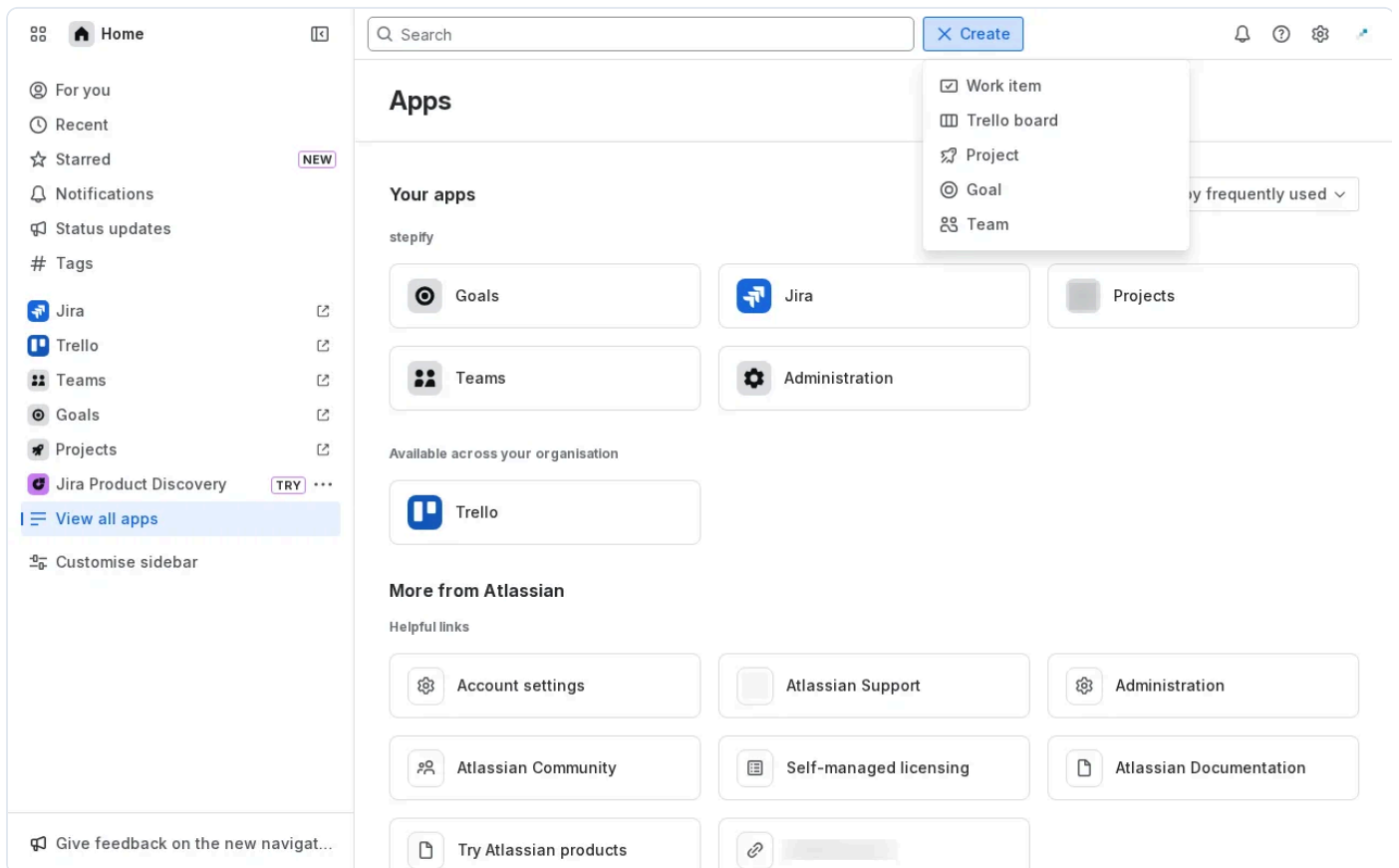

3 Scroll down to find more available apps.



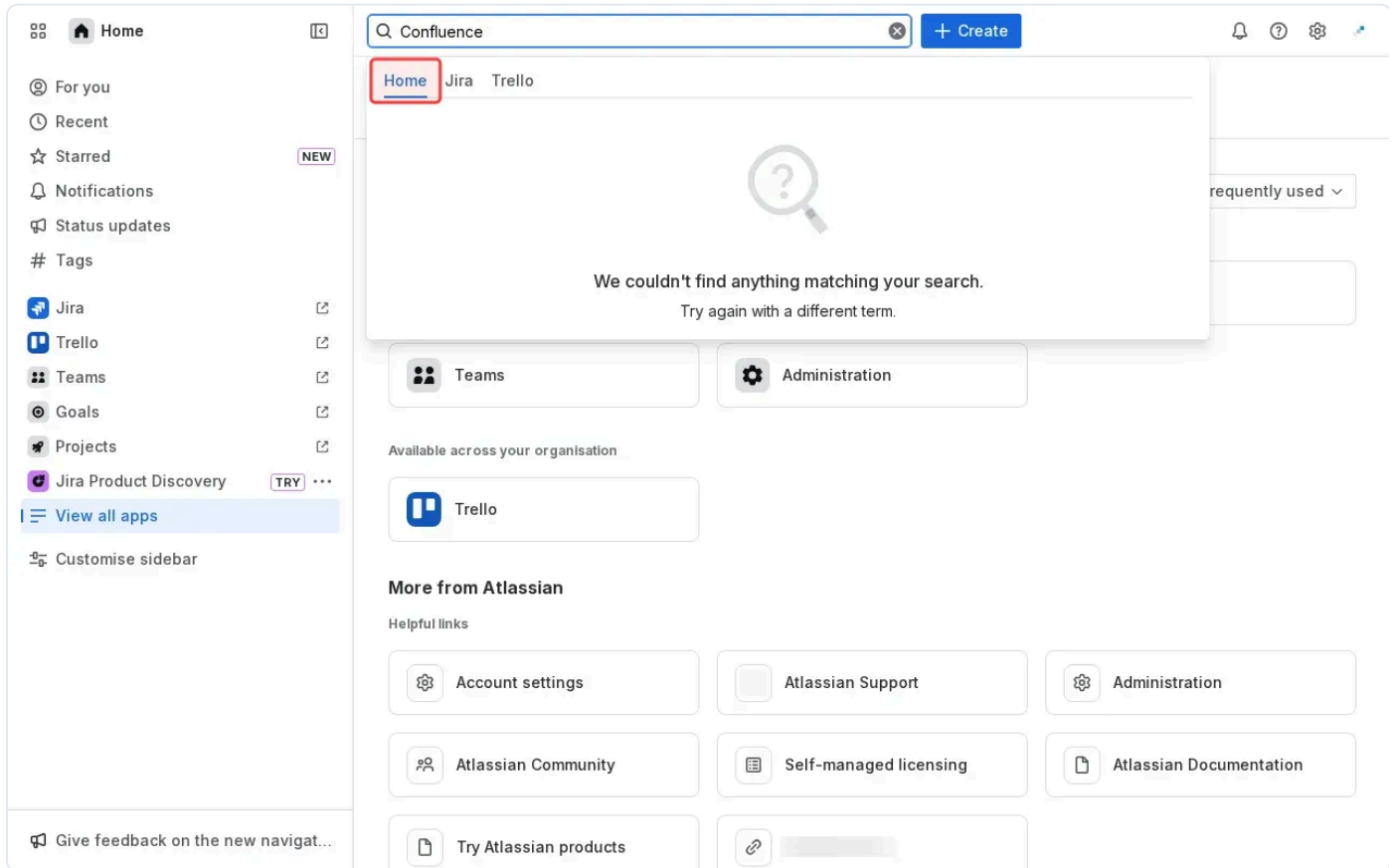
4 Click 'Jira' to access Atlassian workspace.
