


How to create a new scenario that watches for new emails and sends a Slack notification in Make

- 1 Click 'Back to Home' to navigate away from this 404 error page and return to the website builder interface where Hero blocks can be added and edited.

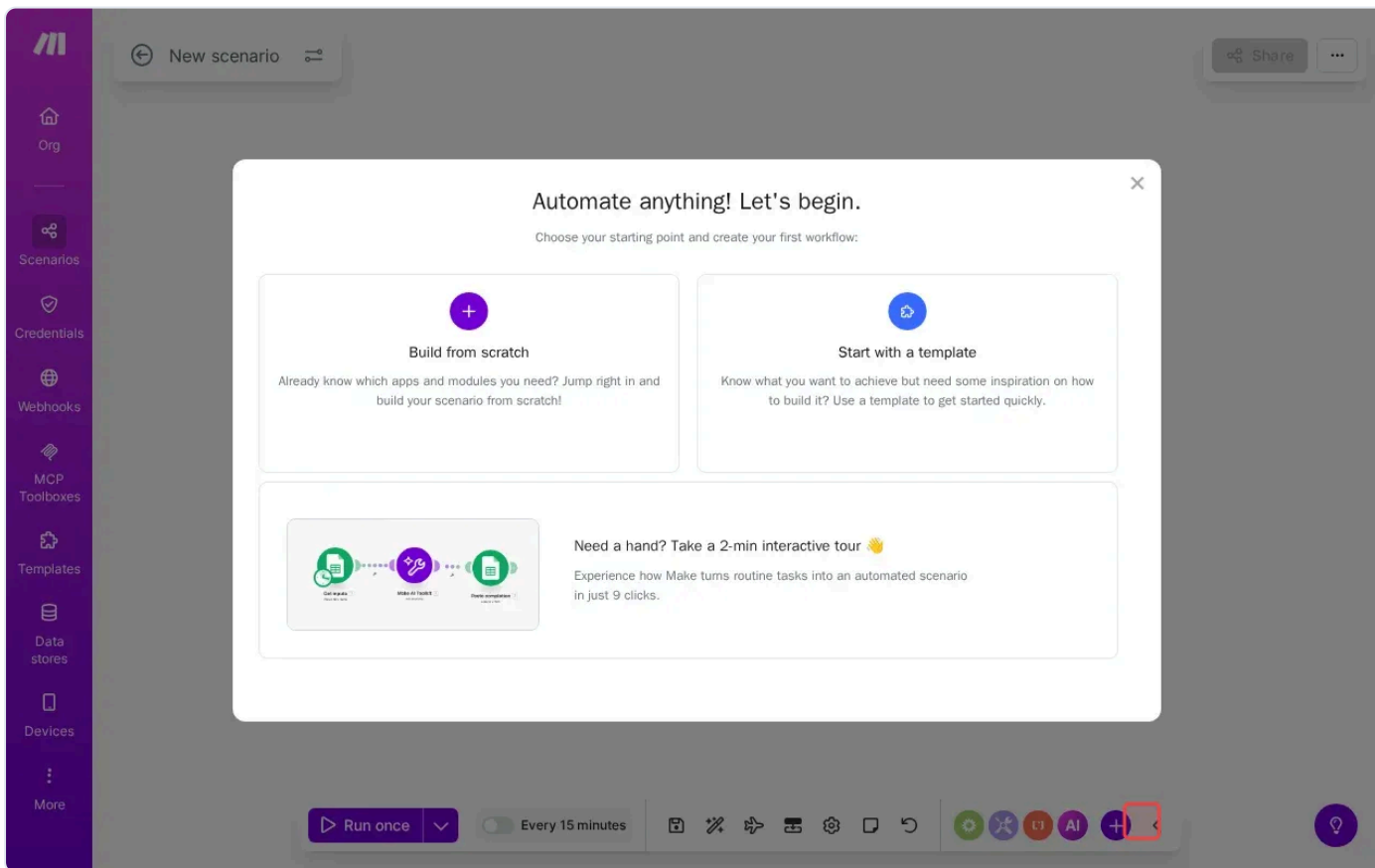
